Another old land mark is shortly to disappear from New Plymouth, the Crown Dairy Company having decided to demolish the old flour mill recently purchased by them in Queen-street. The mill was erected about 50 years and was opened with great colut by a ball, at which most of the people of New Plymouth attended. The mill was then known as the Union Mill and was run for many years by Mr S. Oliver, afterwards passing into the hands of Messrs Honeyfield and Read.
