Mr Wray said recently that he had been shopping at the Kash since it was bought by Mr J. J. Lomas in October 1918.

"I think I was the first customer through the door when Mr Lomas opened up for the first time," Mr Wray said.

"I have kept coming back because of the attentive, civil and friendly attitude started by Mr Lomas and continued by Mr Wood.

"Every time I come in there is a chair for me to sit in and all the staff have a friendly word of greeting."

Mr Wray is a son of the engineer who has responsible for building the railway line from New Plymouth to Waitara, Mr A. Wray.
"He also built and drove

the first steam engine to run on the line. I can remember how he used to have a dog which travelled with him in the cab of the engine," said Mr Wray.

"There were no fences on the railway in those days and the dog was used to drive stray stock from the line. "One day it got rather carried away and the engine ran over its tail, cutting half off, but the dog still went on with the

Mr Wray's father also supervised the building of the New Plymouth reservoir which was demolished a few years ago when the present one was built.

About the only dif-. ference between the clothing worn by the young man about town then and now is the waistcoat. Waistcoats of the mid

1910s had lapels.

Hats in this period were narrow brimmed hard felt, trouser cuffs were narrow and the popular jacket had four but-

From the 1920s on, a change in the width of the trousers became obvious.

Trousers became wider and wider until by 1940 they had gone up from 12 to 16 inches to 21 to 22 inches. In some extreme cases this was taken a step further and bell-bottom

trousers appeared. With the increase in trouser width the jacket lapels and hat brims also increased in width.

These finally reached a maximum of about four inches in width.

Then followed the era

of the double breasted suit. This style was worn by young and old alike and remained in fashion until the mid-1950s.

One notable fashion trend of the late wide trouser and early doublebreasted jacket era was shaped jackets.

These fitted round the waist and did not hang as low on the

body as modern coats.

Today we have returned once more to the narrow trouser cuffs, narrow lapel and narrow hat band. Although four button jackets are not as popular as they were at the beginning of the century a number can be seen on the streets.
