Timata Ora Home Leased To Taranaki Hospital Board

The Timata Ora maternity hospital, New Plymouth, has been leased to the Taranaki Hospital Board for a term of three years. According to a report presented by the secretary of the board at a meeting at New Plymouth yesterday, the board will begin its lease early next year. It is intended to sub-let the hospital to joint licensees.

Approval of a subsidy at the rate of £1260 a year, had been granted by the former Minister of Health, Miss M. B. Howard, to be paid to the joint licensees on the understanding that the subsidy is to be reviewed at the end of one year, or in the event of the hospital being conducted by one licensee only, stated the report.

The capital outlay involved in completely equipping the hospital and paying for alterations and renovations is estimated at £3000, with an annual maintenance charge of £1600 for rent and subsidy.
