
Improvements to church





EXTENSIVE ALTERATIONS and improvements are in progress at the Holy Trinity Anglican Church, Fitzroy. The two sides of the building are being extended at least 12 feet, to provide more seating within the church. The improvements will bring the building's capacity to 200 people. The Vicar, Rev. F. Cook, said an increase in attendance at the church had necessitated the work. Only 140 people could be seated previously. The entire building would be restored, re-roofed and painted and the grounds improved. The work would cost about £4500. The top photograph shows preparations for extending one wall of the church being made by workmen today. Part of the original building (right) which was opened in 1845, has been re-roofed and restored. The original split-shingle roof was found when the old iron was removed. LOWER:
