



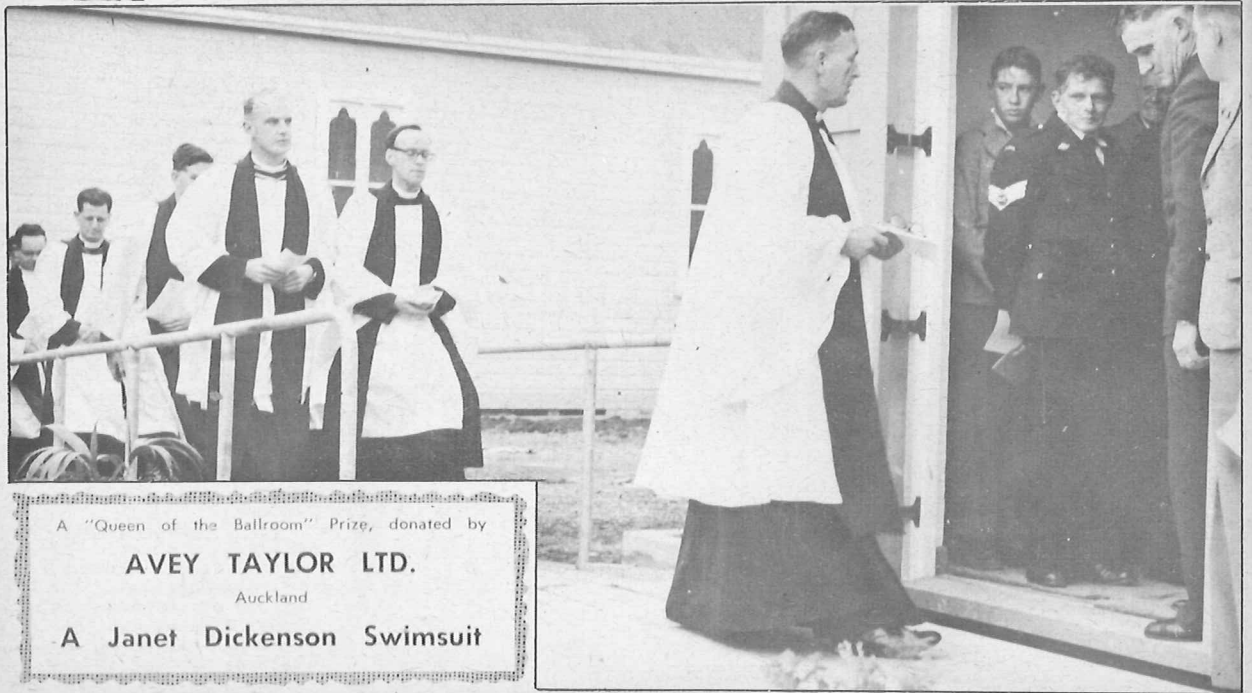
St. John's Anglican Church, Waitara, Dedicated

The new St. John's Anglican Church at Waitara had a capacity congregation for its dedication recently by the Bishop of Waikato, the Rt. Rev. J.T.Holland. Less than an hour before the ceremony, the workmen were still putting the final touches to the church and its surrounds in preparation for this very important function.

The dedication service began with a procession of clergy. At the main door of the church, the Bishop was met by the vicar and churchwardens and requested to dedicate the church "to the honour and glory of God, under the name of Saint John the Baptist."
