## MAORI WAR HERO

REMAINS RE-INTERRED AT PATEA.

VERSION OF DEATH DISPROVED.

Constant erosion of the river bank at Patea has threatened the grave of Charles Broughton, who lost his life in the Maori War. Following representations by the Patea Returned Soldiers' Association to the Department of Internal Affairs drawing attention to the danger of the grave being swept away the Patea Cemetery Board had the remains disinterred and taken to the Patea cemetery on Wednesday.

How Mr. Broughton met his death has been a controversial point among historians, the most popular story being that he was ambushed while acting as a liaison officer to the Imperial forces at Patea and up-river natives. His headless body was believed to have been found floating down the river and to have been buried where it was washed ashore. It was discovered yesterday, however, that the skull was with the remains. Another version of the affair is that he was murdered at Otola, as is recounted in Mr. James Cowan's book.
