In order to remove any misunderstanding that may still exist as to the site and nature of the memorial we may explain once more that it will take the form of a cenotaph of similar design to that in Whitehall, London, and that it will be erected on an island site in the middle of Queen Street, which is to be widened for the purpose, near its junction with St. Aubyn Street.
