


103 Devon Street West

The former C T Mills building at 103 Devon Street West is now a non-descript two-storied timber building. In its original form however, it was a handsome 19th century building: it had four round-headed openings on the ground floor, with panelling, cornice and parapet above, the whole composition capped with three urns on the parapet. The original form is shown in early photos (see Inventory item Group 1, building at extreme right of historic photo) and in the original architect's drawing. It would be possible to restore the front elevation of this building.
