NEW TARANAKI WOMEN'S CLUB ROOMS READY

One of New Plymouth's oldest homes, built more than 80 years ago, is being occupied, following renovation, by the Taranaki Women's Club. It is the house in Powderham Street originally occupied by the Skinner family at its original site on Devon Street. Part of the building was occupied yesterday.

By tomorrow the women's club should have completed its move from its previous quarters in Devon Street. Renovation of the house will be completed when the area between the house and footpath has been laid out in gardens.

The first official function in the new rooms will be a Christmas party on Wednesday. The club's gardening circle held the last social afternoon in the old rooms on Wednesday.
