
50 Homes, £1675 For Hall

In time to receive the Government's subsidy residents of Bird, Ohura and Skinner Roads, Stratford, raised £1,675 for their district war memorial hall. The target was £1,500, but the very fine community spirit of an area containing only just over 50 homes exceeded this sum before the end of June.

The hall, which will be the first one the district has ever had, is to be built on Skinner Road, and a site for it has already been found. Social events and meetings were previously held in the Bird Road school, which was, however, not suitable.

The secretary of the memorial hall committee, Mr. H. A. L. Hann, said

the hall will be built by voluntary labour with some technical help.

"It will take us a year or more to get the hall built, but we intend to make a start soon and push ahead as fast as we can," Mr. Hann said. Most of the money was received from direct donations.
