
Former Well-known Farmer Dies After Fall

Formerly a well-known farmer in the Stratford district and for more than 30 years a resident of New Plymouth, Mr. James Charlton Robson died at the New Plymouth hospital yesterday after a fall in which he broke his hip at his home in St. Aubyn Street, New Plymouth, on New Year's Eve. He was 81 years old.

Born at Ngaere, Mr. Robson farmed at Pukengahu for many years before retiring about 40 years ago. Since then he had lived at Hawera, Wellington and Stratford and finally at New Plymouth. He was a member of the New Plymouth Bowling Club.

Mr. Robson is survived by his wife, who is a patient in a New Plymouth private hospital.
