
Flagstaff Planned As War Memorial For Inglewood Area

A plan of the flagstaff the Inglewood War Memorial Committee proposes to erect as a war memorial on the lawns opposite the post office was submitted to the Inglewood Borough Council last night by Mr. V. Birt. The flagstaff would be 50 feet or 51 feet high. It was hoped that it would be erected by Christmas.

The mast would be surrounded by a concrete base eight feet in diameter, said Mr. Birt. Each of the guy rope anchors would be surrounded by concrete bases three feet in diameter, each anchor being 12 feet from the foot of the flagstaff. The shortest distance of a guy rope anchor from the pavement would be 25 feet.

Councillors suggested that the committee should consider extending the concrete base surrounding the flagstaff to take in the guy rope anchors. It was also thought that instead of the guy ropes running down to ground level, they should be attached to torsion rods.

The council's views are to be conveyed to the memorial committee.
